## Introduction

FlexNet Agent 5.3.2 retrieves and communicates data for two of Flexera Software’s usage-reporting web applications—FlexNet Manager for Engineering Applications and FlexNet Manager for Cloud Infrastructure.

## Using with FlexNet Manager for Engineering Applications

FlexNet Agent 5.3.2 supports the administrative capabilities of FlexNet Manager for Engineering Applications to manage a FlexNet Publisher licensing environment. FlexNet Agent 5.3.2 supports both single-server configurations and triad configurations for serving licenses.

# Using with FlexNet Manager for Cloud Infrastructure

Installed on-premise at your enterprise, FlexNet Agent 5.3.2 retrieves your organization's Amazon Web Services (AWS) usage and billing data, and sends it to FlexNet Manager for Cloud Infrastructure. There, the data is used to populate two persona-targeted dashboards—Financial Dashboard and Operational Dashboard—and is used in over 20 different reports.

## Resolved Issues

The release of FlexNet Agent 5.3.2 resolves the following issues.

Issue	Description
<b>IOJ-1754027</b>	FlexNet Agent 5.x fails to rotate report-log file to a location outside of the FlexNet Publisher license-server installation.
<b>IOJ-1728585</b>	FlexNet Agent 5.3 installed with logging set to "debug" mode. Users are unable to change the mode.
